**What:** Start your day off with an early morning 5k run with spectacular ocean views, along some of the most beautiful beaches in The Bahamas. Join fellow Torch Runners on a very special cadence run around Atlantis Paradise Island. Starting at the Flying Horses fountain just outside the Royal Towers entrance we will follow the perimeter walkway and public roads around Atlantis Paradise Island. This event will be a group not a timed event. A shorter (3K) route for walkers that still lets you experience the beauty of the Bahamas will be incorporated into this event for those who do not wish to run but still want to participate.

**Where:** The course is approximately 2.75 miles and mostly flat with some very minor grades. Runners will need to maintain orderly columns as they approach The Reef Atlantis and wind their way along the lush garden trail toward Cove Beach. The runners will parallel the ocean and its spectacular views, passing Paradise Lagoon and Atlantis Beach West before reaching the park like setting and return run along Paradise Island Drive.

**When:** Stage in front of the Flying Horses fountain in the parking lot just outside the Royal Towers entrance Saturday October 3, at 6:30 a.m. The run will begin promptly at 7:00 a.m.



**How:** Runners and walkers can register for this event in the conference registration area between 8:00 a.m. Wednesday and 5:00 p.m. Friday. The cost is \$25 USD per person which includes a dry fit T-Shirt specific to this event. All participants must sign the Release and Waiver of Liability at the time of registration. Proceeds from this event support Special Olympics Bahamas.
